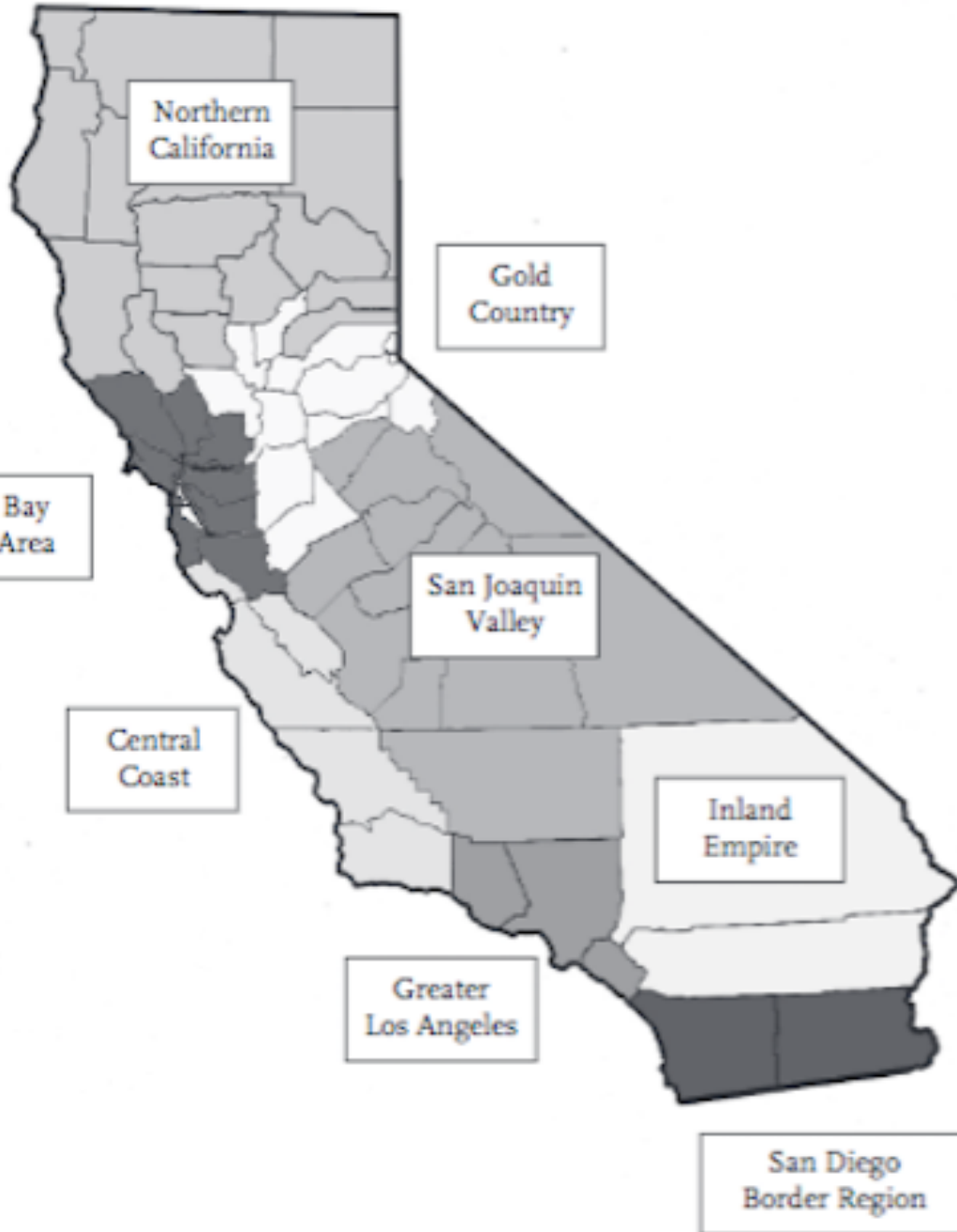


**Plan for a New California State Legislature: A single house - the California State Assembly - with 500 Members: 1/2 elected from smaller single-seat districts by ranked choice voting, 1/2 from regional multi-seat districts by proportional representation**

*The # of seats from each region is proportional to its population, with each region's counties listed:*



**Northern California (13 members - 6 from single-seat districts / 7 from multi-seat districts):** Counties - Del Norte, Humboldt, Lake, Lassen, Mendocino, Modoc, Nevada, Plumas, Sierra, Siskiyou, Trinity, Butte, Colusa, Glenn, Shasta, Tehama

**Gold Country (48 members - 24/24):** Placer, Sacramento, San Joaquin, Stanislaus, Sutter, Yolo, Yuba

**San Joaquin Valley (39 members - 19/20):** Fresno, Kern, Kings, Madera, Tulare, Merced, Calaveras, Inyo, Mariposa, Mono, Tuolumne

**Bay Area (98 members - 49/49):** Alameda, Contra Costa, Marin, Napa, San Francisco, San Mateo, Santa Clara, Solano, Sonoma

**Central Coast (19 members - 9/10):** Monterey, San Benito, San Luis Obispo, Santa Barbara, Santa Cruz

**Greater Los Angeles (181 members - 91/90):** Los Angeles, Orange, Ventura

**Inland Empire (58 members - 29/29):** Riverside, San Bernardino

**San Diego Border (44 members - 22/22):** Imperial, San Diego
